Med arb is a promising but difficult dispute resolution procedure. It is obviously needed but few practitioners and centres actually use it. We will discuss this procedure and see if and how we can make it successful.

Dispute prevention and the maintenance of ongoing relationships is an area of growing importance for the parties. The Forum will look at ways to provide efficient services to prevent conflict in contracts and discuss the possibility for centres to enter this activity.

The intervention of an Ombudsman is also one of the ways to manage possible disputes and resolve existing ones. Obviously Ombudsmen and mediators have a lot in common. With the participation of the International Ombudsmen Association we shall explore this important field.

The UIA World Forum of Mediation Centres wants you to remain at the forefront of conflict prevention and resolution. This meeting is to help you to do so.
