



The Russian Telecoms and IT Authority (Roskomnadzor) agrees to upload into WIPO ALERT information about copyright infringing websites

The Russian Federal Service for the supervision of communications, information technology and mass media (Roskomnadzor) is reported to have signed with the WIPO a memorandum on the supply of information to WIPO ALERT database (<https://www.wipo.int/wipo-alert/en/>).

The WIPO ALERT database contains details of websites, which are reported by national authorities to infringe copyright.

The lists of infringing websites are available to the authorized users of the

system to prevent the placing of advertisements on infringing sites and damaging their reputation.

The Roskomnadzor will be feeding into WIPO ALERT the information of which it disposes about Internet sites featuring copyrighted and protected works which were uploaded without the authorization of the rightholder more than once.

It was reported that the signature of the WIPO memorandum by the Roskomnadzor was the result of 1,5 years preparatory work and is a step further put in place against pirated content in the Internet.
